1. Dates and Deadlines

\$200- This project was established in 1973 to provide need based grants to women in the US and Canada whose education has been interrupted and who find it necessary to return to school.

Answer -What is PCE?

\$400- Chapters submit forms online between August 15th and October 15th and recipients are announced annually by April 30th.

Answer- What is STAR Scholarship?

\$600- This institution was founded in 1884 with the firm belief that women deserved the same quality education as men. When it's founder Virginia Alice became a member of the P.E.O. Sisterhood, she realized that P.E.O. paralleled her own goals and ideas about higher education for women. In 1927 The P.E.O. Sisterhood accepted the institution as a gift and has been making excellent Educational Opportunities for women ever since.

Answer- What is Cottey College?

\$800- This project was established in 1949 to provide scholarships for International Women to pursue graduate study in the US or Canada.

Answer- What is IPS?

\$1,000- Nominations are accepted from P.E.O. chapters between August 20th and November 20th each year. Nominees have 45 days to complete their online application once their nomination is submitted. Awards are announced by May 1st.

Answer- What are the P.E.O. Scholar Awards.

2. Award Amounts

\$200- Maximum amounts are:

\$12,000 for a non-degree program/Associates

\$15,000- bachelor's degree

\$20,000 for Master's Degree

\$25,000 for Doctoral Degree

Answer- What is ELF?

\$400- Maximum grant is typically \$4,000 however in 2023 this project celebrated 50 years by awarding 50 special anniversary grants in the amount of \$5,000.

Answer- What is PCE?

\$600- This project awards a onetime gift of \$2,500 to exceptional high school seniors.

Answer- What is STAR Scholarship?

\$800-Maximum award amount for this project is \$12,500

Answer- What is IPS?

\$1,000- Maximum award amount for this project is \$25,000.

Answer- What are the P.E.O. Scholar Awards?

3. Rules and Requirements

\$200-This project is for Doctoral Level candidates and can be used to provide partial support for study and research.

Answer- What is P.E.O. Scholar Awards?

\$400- This project provides financial assistance to women from outside the US and Canada who are seeking advanced degrees from an accredited college or university in the U.S. or Canada with the expectation that students will return to their home countries to utilize their education to make a positive impact and foster global peace.

Answer- What is the P.E.O. International Peace Scholarship?

\$600- This is the only P.E.O. project that requires a minimum credit score of 625.

Answer- What is the P.E.O. Educational Loan Fund?

\$800- Applicants plan to attend an accredited postsecondary education institution in the United States or Canada full time or part time in the fall of the academic year following their high school graduation.

Answer- What is the P.E.O. Star Scholarship?

\$1,000- To be eligible for this project a student must have at least 24 consecutive months as a non-student and be within 18 months of completing their educational program which once concluded will lead to employment or job advancement.
