A P.E.O. SCHOLAR AWARDS GAME

Directions: This game is played like the TV game show, "Jeopardy". Divide those present into two groups with the project Chairman acting as moderator. The moderator gives the ANSWER (Listed First) and the groups alternate answering "What is" or "who is", etc. The group with the most correct questions formed wins the game.

Example: Fifth project. (What is the P.E.O. Scholar Awards?)

- 1. November 20. (What is the nomination deadline?)
- 2. Majority voice vote. (What is the method of voting when a chapter nominates a woman for the P.E.O. Scholar Awards?)
- 3. May 1. (What is the date the P.E.O. Scholar Awards winners are announced?)
- 4. No age. (What is the age limit for the award?)
- 5. Upon receipt of the student's confirmation of enrollment, and early February (What are the dates the scholar receives her monetary award?)
- 6. Academic excellence. (What is the P.E.O. Scholar Awards based on?)
- 7. Two years. (What is the applicant's time frame for completion of her degree?)
- 8. U.S. or Canada. (From what two countries may nominees apply?)
- 9. Advanced study & research. (What are the P.E.O. Scholar Awards used for?)
- 10. Doctoral study. (What is the level of study for this project?)
- 11. Three letters of reference. (What does an applicant need professors/professional to recommend her for the P.E.O. Scholar Awards?)
- 12. 1991. (What year was the project adopted?)
- 13. A letter of knowledge of the candidate. (What does the chapter send with the nomination form?)
- 14. Three-member trustee board. (Who selects the recipients?)
- 15. Chapter contributions. (What is our responsibility for the support of this project?)
- 16. Total amount of contributions. (What determines the number and amount of awards each year?)
- 17. Full time student. (Status a nominee must be in order to receive a P.E.O. Scholar Award?)

- 18. Online to P.E.O. Scholar Awards, P.E.O. Executive Office (Where is the completed nomination form sent?)
- 19. In two installments. (How is the award paid?)
- 20. August 20. (What is the date the P.E.O. Scholar Awards office begins accepting applications each year?)
- 21. Personal contact & encouragement. (What are the responsibilities of the local chapter toward their recipient?)
- 22. A woman with academic excellence, maturity, seriousness of purpose, pursuing graduate level study or research, within 2 years of completion, with at least 1 academic year remaining, who agrees to pursue her studies full time.? (Who is eligible for the award?)
