

PCEJeopardy

A Chapter Team-Building Game

Is your knowledge of PCE in jeopardy? Test your chapter understanding of the P.E.O. Program for Continuing Education while enjoying this engaging team-building exercise. Game categories include: PCE Eligibility, PCE Grant Conditions and the PCE Online Applications Process.

Preparations before the Meeting:

- Print copy of category pages for moderator
- Print copies of the score sheet for teams to keep a tally of their earned points
- Gather supplies:
 - ✓ Noise makers (kazoos, hand bells, whistles, etc.)
 - ✓ Prizes (i.e. gold foil coins for first place team, silver wrapped kisses for second, lemon drops for third
 - ✓ Pair of dice

Set up:

- Form three teams and provide each with a score sheet.
- Give each team a distinctive noisemaker.

Playing the Game:

- One member of each team rolls the dice to determine which team goes first; highest number wins the call. The winning team chooses the category and number (i.e.: "We'll take Eligibility for ten").
- The PCE chair, serving as the moderator, should keep the pace fast and fun as she reads the answer(s) for the requested number(s).
- The designated team provides the question to correspond with the answer.
- If the designated team does not know the question or provides an incorrect question, the team that responds with their noise maker next states the question; if correct that team continues with another requested number; if incorrect, the remaining team tries for the correct question.
- When none of the teams know the question to the answer, the moderator shares the correct question.
- Continue the answer/question exchange until all categories and questions are covered.
- Add scores and award prizes accordingly

PCE JEOPARDY GAME CATEGORIES

PCE ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility for ten:

An applicant cannot be considered for a PCE grant without this type of sponsorship.

Question: What is the local chapter?

Eligibility for twenty:

Citizenship or legal permanent residence and location of educational institutions must be in either of these two countries.

Question: What are the United States and Canada?

Eligibility for thirty:

The period of time the applicant must have been a non-student sometime in her adult lifetime.

Question: What is at least twenty-four consecutive months?

Eligibility for forty:

At this educational level an applicant can no longer apply for a PCE grant.

Question: What is once she has already earned a master's degree or above?

Eligibility for fifty:

Maximum consecutive number of months remaining in which the applicant must complete her course of study

Question: What is 18 months?

Bonus Round for one hundred:

This is the opportunity to determine the applicant's eligibility, learn her story, her educational goals and financial plan.

Question: What is the candidate interview with the chapter PCE committee?

PCE GRANT CONDITIONS

Grant Conditions for ten:

PCE grants are awarded based on available funds and individual need up to this maximum amount.

Question: What is \$4,000? (Effective 2/14/2024)

Grant Conditions for twenty:

PCE grant funds are intended for these necessary expenses to reach the applicant's educational goal.

Question: What are tuition, books, fees, other education related expenses, childcare, Equipment/tools necessary for the course of study and transportation?

Grant Conditions for thirty:

A PCE grant cannot be used for these situations.

Question: What are living expenses, repayment of educational loans or the cost of prerequisite courses?

Grant Conditions for forty:

Applicant is in her final course of study to improve marketable skills for employment or advancement in her career in order to support herself and/or her family.

Question: What are primary objectives and requirements of the applicant's educational goal?

Grant Conditions for fifty:

A candidate who needs this in order to gain employment in her field cannot be considered for a grant.

Question: What is an additional degree?

Bonus Round for one hundred:

Gifts of \$4,000 entitle the donor to designate an award as an honorarium or memorial. (Effective 2/14/2024)

Question: What is a PCE Named Grant?

PCE ONLINE APPLICATION

Online Application for ten:

Interviewing the PCE Candidate and the Candidate's Pre-Application Income and Expense Guide & Worksheet are two tools a chapter may use to assist a chapter in sponsoring a PCE grant candidate and are located in this specific area of the P.E.O. International website.

Question: What is the Resources section of the P.E.O. International website?

Online Application for twenty:

This document used in the applicant interview will assist the chapter contact in completing the chapter online forms.

Question: What is the Chapter's Pre-Application Worksheet?

Online Application for thirty:

The chapter PCE contact completes this online form that includes a set of questions to tell the candidate's story.

Question: What is the Chapter Recommendation Form?

Online Application for forty:

It takes approximately this much time for the PCE Chapter Contact to receive a systemgenerated email confirming the successful submission of the *Chapter Recommendation Form* after clicking on the "Submit" button.

Question: What is 15 minutes or less?

Online application for fifty:

Once the application forms are completed and submitted by the applicant, this facilitator will communicate directly with the applicant and/or chapter contact if there are errors or conflicting information.

Question: Who is the PCE project supervisor at the Executive Office in Des Moines?

Bonus Round for one hundred:

When reviewing the *Candidate's Pre-Application Income and Expense Guide & Worksheet,* the chapter contact must confirm that an applicant with a monthly educational or income deficit give a more detailed financial plan.

Question: What is the applicant's financial plan for covering unmet expenses?
