GET THE FACTS ABOUT PCE!

PCE is a need-based grant program providing onetime financial assistance to women whose education has been interrupted and who find it necessary to return to school to complete a degree or certification that improves their marketable skills for employment to support themselves and/or their families.

The maximum grant amount is **\$4,000**.

A woman is eligible for recommendation by a local chapter if she:

- Is a citizen of the US or Canada;
- Is enrolled in an accredited certification or degree program;
- Is living and studying in the US or Canada for the entire course of study;
- Has had 24 consecutive months as a non-student sometime in her adult life;
- Is within 18 consecutive months of completing her educational program that at the conclusion of will lead to employment or job advancement.

<u>PCE grant money may be used for:</u> Tuition and testing fees; books and supplies; equipment, tools and required uniforms; transportation expenses; and childcare expenses while in school.

The application process is as follows:

- 1. Chapter identifies prospective applicant(s).
- 2. Chapter PCE chair will arrange an interview to determine eligibility using the *Chapter's PCE Pre-Application Worksheet* and *Candidate's PCE Pre-Application Income & Expense Guide and Worksheet,* available in the Resources section of the P.E.O. International website.
- 3. Chapter approval is granted by a majority vote.
- 4. *Chapter Recommendation Form* is submitted (electronically) No less than 8 weeks or more than 14 weeks prior to the start date of the term for which the grant is requested.
- 5. Instructions will be emailed to the applicant, including the specific deadline (30 days) for submitting her completed forms.
- 6. Board of trustees evaluates application.

 Notification letter will be emailed to local chapter PCE contact for presentation of a certificate to the recipient. The check will be deposited directly into the recipient's bank account. Recipients in Canada will receive a check.

The Chapter Recommendation Form should tell the candidate's story! Make sure that the information gathered during the candidate interview addresses the three essay questions stated on the **Chapter's PCE Pre-Application Worksheet**. These three questions constitute the actual recommendation.

And finally, remember to STAY IN TOUCH with the applicant during and after the application process. The relationship between a recipient and her sponsoring chapter provides the valuable support needed to finish her education.

Fun Facts:

A PCE candidate is eligible to apply for an ELF loan and PCE grant concurrently!

A gift of \$4,000 entitles the donor to designate a **PCE Named Grant** as an honorarium or memorial!

A gift of \$500 designates the chapter as a **Brighter Tomorrow Chapter**.
